## 1

### EMAIL YOUR CLIENTS

Send an email to your current list of clients and ask them to "Like" your page on Facebook. Inform them that they will receive incentives such as specials and access to the latest news.

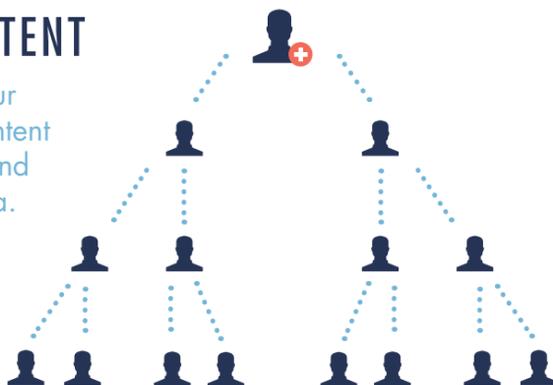
